

Mursley Parish Plan Survey & Questionnaire

You may have read about it in Open Gates, you may have attended the meeting on the Parish Plan at the Village Hall last year. This is now your opportunity to provide your views on a number of subjects all of which are of relevance to you as a resident of this Parish.

The answers you give to the questions in this survey will be analysed and the results will be published as the Mursley Parish Plan. The more replies we receive, the more accurately we will reflect the views of all sections of our community.

You will have helped:

- To identify the local features and characteristics that you value.
- You will have highlighted your concerns, pet hates, and a wish list of things the Parish currently does not have but you would like to see.
- You will have stated how you would like to see the Village develop in the future.

From all of this information the Parish Plan will identify specific things that you would like to happen and prepare a plan of action to achieve those aims.

A parish plan is not just a piece of paper that will be ignored by everyone. Whilst the views that we all express will not be binding Parish, District and County Councils and anyone wishing to carry out work that will affect the Parish will be obliged to take the views expressed in the Parish Plan into account when making decisions that affect us.

We would like to receive replies from every resident in the village old enough to express a view of their own. Responses from young people under the age of 18 will be reported separately and this is why if you are 17 and under we ask that you indicate your precise age on the front sheet. We also ask that you give your postcode, this will help us to know if the views from one part of the Parish differ from another on any particular subject. Otherwise, if you wish, you can remain anonymous other than when completing the section expressing personal interests. That information is merely so that we can put people with similar interests in touch with each other. All other information provided is for statistical purposes only, and no individual's views will be attributed to in the final Parish Plan.

* *Definition of Affordable Housing:*

This would be a small village development of homes funded by Government and administered by a housing association under the auspices of Aylesbury Vale District Council intended for subsidised rent or shared ownership to persons meeting quite a strict local connection. Mursley, like most villages, has no accommodation that many people can afford to buy or rent and affordable housing schemes have been introduced to enable, for instance, children who have grown up here to remain residents rather than be forced to move away when they leave home. Sometimes it could be a couple who have started a family and now find the loss of an income makes it impossible to stay here.

In all cases a local connection will have to be satisfied in order to be eligible for tenancy and the homes always remain in the public domain even if of shared ownership status where there is a maximum permitted percentage of ownership which can be sold on only to others meeting the residency rules or back to the housing association.

The housing needs survey conducted by the Parish Council in conjunction with the Buckinghamshire Rural Housing Enabler identified a big demand for such accommodation with nearly double the number of questionnaires returned compared with normal surveys from which 75% expressed support for affordable housing in Mursley.
